## **Campus Minister**

## Job Description

The Campus Minister is someone ordained for Christian Ministry who will report and remain accountable to the Director. The focus of the position will be to facilitate and implement a strategy for the development and growth of the ministry on campus. This individual should be able to coordinate and lead a team of people striving toward a common vision. Campus Ministers are expected to abide by the policies and procedures outlined in Impact's Handbook. Typical duties expected include, but are not limited to:

- Maintaining Campus Relations and Status as a Registered Student Organization
- Organizing Efforts to Engage Campus and Meet Students
- Guiding a Plan to Train and Mentor Students
- Facilitating Plans for Preaching and Teaching
- Organizing and Training a Team of Student Leaders
- Coordinating Retreats and Mission Trips
- Networking with Local Churches and Organizations
- Fundraising and Corresponding with Supporters
- Oversee Campus House Functions and Projects (Resident Selection, Maintenance)

## Secondary aspects of the position include:

- Cooperation toward completion of Impact's quarterly newsletter
- Assisting in the proposal and implementation of a yearly budget
- Facilitating a social media presence
- Participation and correspondence with a Board of Directors
- Supporting efforts to strengthen support locally and regionally

## **Salary**

This position will be responsible for fundraising a designated salary (as approved by the Board of Directors) to be paid in regular bi-weekly amounts. Annual salary evaluations will be performed.
