

CSU Campus Minister

Summary

There are over 200,000 college students scattered along the front range, and this unique season of life provides combines to present incredible opportunities to engage the next generation with the gospel. Established in the 1980s, Impact has long served young adults on their journey with God and owns a home next to the CSU campus which has served as a spring board for the ministry. We are currently seeking full-time staff who are passionate about serving this unique population on their faith journey. Staff would work to restart a ministry at CSU. The day-to-day work would include things like coordinating efforts to meet new students, cultivating relationships, mentoring and teaching. Staff would be expected to raise a partial salary and pay would be based upon candidate qualifications and experience.

Job Description

The CSU Ministry staff will report and remain accountable to the Board of Directors. The primary focus of the position will be the development and growth of the ministry at Colorado State University. Typical duties expected include, but are not limited to:

- Re-establishing and Maintaining Status as a Registered Student Organization
- Organizing Efforts to Engage the CSU Campus
- Small Group Discipleship and Teaching
- Developing a Team of Student Leaders
- Coordinating Activities, Retreats and Mission Trips
- Networking with Churches and other Organizations
- Fundraising and Corresponding with Supporters

Secondary aspects of the position include:

- Cooperation toward completion of quarterly newsletter
- Assisting in the proposal and implementation of a yearly budget
- Facilitating a social media presence
- Participation and correspondence with a Board of Directors
- Supporting efforts to strengthen support locally and regionally
- Corroborating with other staff in the development and growth of other ministries

Salary

This position will be responsible for fundraising a partial salary (as approved by the Board of Directors) to be paid in regular bi-weekly amounts. New staff will participate in fundraising training to assist with this task. Annual salary evaluations will be performed.

Relocation Expenses

Impact will re-imburse up to \$1,000 for moving expenses.
