Job Description

Interns will work under the supervision of a Campus Minister and/or Director. The primary focus of the position will be to assist the development and growth of Impact's ministry. This role will provide the intern with valuable training and experience for future ministry service. This role will also incorporate some ongoing educational material coordinated by the Campus Minister and/or Director. Interns are expected to abide by the policies and procedures outlined in Impact's Handbook. Typical duties expected include, but are not limited to:

- Collaborating with and Participating in Efforts to Engage Campus and Meet Students
- Investing Relationally in Students and Cultivating the Campus Ministry Community
- Hosting or Organizing Various Activities and Discipleship Studies
- Participation in Leadership Meetings and Ministry Planning
- Ongoing Educational Development as Outlined by Campus Minister/Director

Secondary aspects of the position include:

- Cooperation with other Ministry Efforts, Activities, and Service Opportunities
- Regular Correspondence and Communication with the Campus Minister/Director
- Occasional Responsibilities Preaching and/or Teaching
- Periodic Participation with Activities at Other Ministry Locations

Salary

This position will be responsible for fundraising a designated salary (as approved by the Board of Directors) to be paid in regular bi-weekly amounts. Annual salary evaluations will be performed.
